



Android 13 Interactive Flat Panel Instruction Manual (HL series)



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1. SAFETY AND PRECAUTIONS

Incorrect use can lead to an electric shock or a fire accident. To prevent dangerous situations, follow the following instructions when installing and cleaning the native machine; to ensure your safety and extend the interactive flat panel service life, read the following safety precautions carefully.

[Place]

- Do not place the machine in an unstable and easily inclined position.
- Do not place the machine in direct sunlight, near heating objects such as electric

heating, or other heat sources and strong light sources.

- Do not place the machine near highly radiated equipment.
- Do not place the machine where it is wet or dripping.
- Do not insert any items into the machine.
- Do not place heavy objects on the machine.

[Power Supply]

• Check and ensure that the voltage value of the nameplate on the rear shell matches the main supply voltage value.

- Unplug the power cord and antenna plug during a thunderstorm and lightning weather.
- Please unplug the power plug when the room is unattended or unused for a long time.
- Avoid physical or mechanical damage to the power cord.
- Use a special power cord and do not modify and extend the power cord.
- Check and make sure the AC power ground is on.

[Screen]

- Do not use hard or sharp items instead of a writing pen when writing on the screen.
- Unplug the power plug first when cleaning is required.
- Wipe the screen with a flexible, dust-free, dry cloth.
- Do not clean the machine with water and spray cleaners.
- Do not display the high-brightness pictures on the screen for a long time.

[Range of Visibility]

- The best viewing distance is 5-7 times the diagonal of the screen.
- The best viewing angle is up and down, within 176 degrees.



[Temperature]

- Do not place this machine near an electric heater or radiator.
- When the machine is moved from low temperature area to high temperature area, in

order to distribute the condensation fully, please place it for a period of time and then power on.

• Normal operating temperature of the machine is 5-40°C.

[Humidity]

- Do not expose the machine to rain, wet or near water.
- Please ensure that the room is dry and ventilated.

• Normal operating humidity of the machine is: (20%RH-80%RH); atmospheric pressure: (86kPa-106kPa).

[Ventilation]

• Place the machine in a ventilated place to ensure good heat dissipation.

• Ensure the space ventilation around and behind the whole machine and more than 20 cm on the top.

- The vents do not cover items such as newspapers, tablecloths, and curtains.
- Do not plug any foreign matter into the machine through air vents or openings. There is high voltage inside the machine, inserting a foreign body will cause electric shock or short circuit of internal parts.

[Battery]

• Disused batteries (remote control, etc.) after local use need to be properly disposed of and recycled.

• Do not let the child contact the battery, do not put the battery into the water, to avoid danger.

[Maintenance and maintenance]

- Proper maintenance can prevent many early failures.
- Regular careful cleaning makes the machine look new.
- Unplug the power plug before cleaning and maintenance to prevent electric shock.

[Use and clean]

- It is recommended to vacuuming regularly to ensure proper ventilation.
- Remove the power plug from the AC power outlet before cleaning the local machine.



• Do not use a liquid cleaner or a spray cleaner during cleaning.

• When cleaning the display surface, wipe the cloth with a clean, soft cloth or a special

lens.





2. THE QUICK USE GUIDE

[Start-on for use]



① Connect the power cord tail to the power jack on the back of the machine.

2 Connect the power cord plug to the power supply.

③ Turn on the power switch on the machine and the indicator on the front of the machine is red.

④ Fit the battery correctly according to the positive and negative battery identification on the back of the remote control.

(5) Point the remote control at the remote control reception window of the machine, press the power key of the remote control to turn on, and the indicator shows green.

Note: The built-in computer channel is "built-in computer". For access, use the Input key on the remote control or through the shortcut icon in the suspended ball.

[Use the preparation]

(1) Verify whether the touch is accurate, use the touch pen to write on the multimedia all-



in-one screen, and observe whether the cursor arrow is consistent with the brush, which means that the touch is stable and can be used normally;

5 WRITEING BLACKBOARD.

5.1Writing control.



• The writing control page functions from left to right are: single / multipoint, brush, wipe, select, insert, insert, shape, cancel, and redo.



5.1.1Single / multi-point

• Function description: When switching single / single-point mode, single-point mode, gestures can use two-finger scale canvas, multi-finger mobile canvas and other operations. Single-point mode only supports one writing point, multi-point mode can support multiple writing points and 20-point writing at the same time.

5.1.2paintbrush

- Function description: Set the handwriting front, thickness, and color when writing.
- Brush Thickness: Selects properties in the thickness state
- Pen front: After opening the pen front, the writing will have a pen front effect.
- Brush size: Set the size of the handwriting writing, and support 7 size modes.
- Brush Color: Support for 8 fast brush color settings.
- Brush palette: Support users to customize brush colors.
- Transparency: Supports user defined brush transparency





5.1.3 Erasure

• Function description: erase the handwriting on the canvas, you can choose the rectangular, drawing line, screen cleaning three wipe methods.

• Operation mode: click [Erase] button to switch to wipe mode and pop up the wipe selection menu in three ways. Select [Rectangle wipe] for analog rubber erasure; select [Draw Erasure] to erase the content within the line selection range; select [Slide Clear screen] to clear all the contents of the current page.

• Note: You can also use in the writing process with only erase function, that is, palm erase, according to the different palm size to support three sizes of gesture eraser.



5.1.4 Select

• Function description: Scale, move, rotate, delete and other operations of the selected contents in the canvas.

• Operation mode: Click the [select] button to switch to the selection mode, click the element such as the handwriting or picture on the screen to select the element, and freely draw the element in the optional shape of the closed shape.Select the elements to move, rotate,



zoom, delete, and more.

8. SIMPLE TROUBLESHOOTING

(1) The machine is automatically shutdown

- Is there a sleep standby set up.
- Detect for a sudden power outage.
- Check for no signal standby.

(2) Invalid touch function

- Detects the touch connector for damage or poor port contact.
- Detects whether the touch HID device is recognized.

(3) External speakers have a noise

- Check the external speakers or wire for electromagnetic interference.
- Plug their headphones in the earphone hole of the computer module, listen to whether there is noise, if not, for the speaker problem, need to replace the external speaker.

(4) The equipment has three no (indicator light is not on, no sound, no light) and other faults.

- Check that the power cord is well connected.
- Is the power supply of the power cable outlet normal.
- Whether the equipment power switch is turned on.

(5) The HDMI channel input has no signal.

- Whether the input source is normal.
- Replace the HDMI interface or the wire.
- If you is external computer input, set HDMI output settings on the computer side.

(6) External VGA signal, image display offset.

- Press MENU, with the remote control then select Automatic Correction.
- Try replacing the VGA port or the wire.
